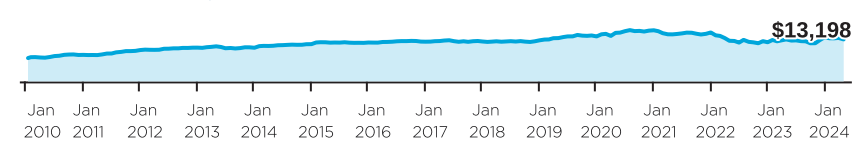

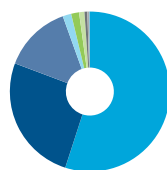

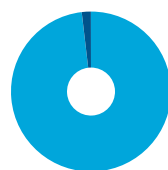


ASSET ALLOCATION



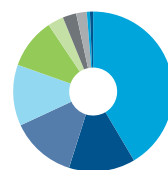
