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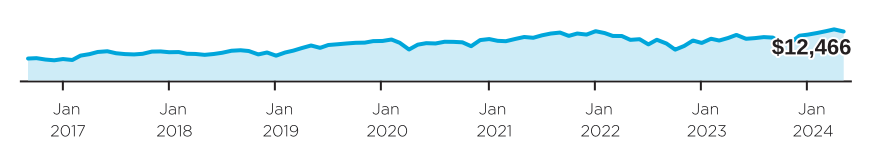

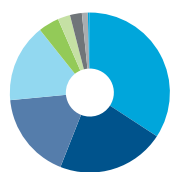

GROWTH OF \$10,000

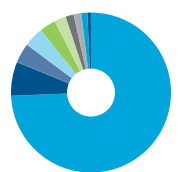


ASSET ALLOCATION<sup>8</sup>



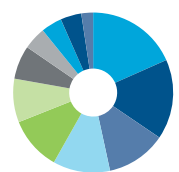
